Day 1 | Arrive San José

Trendy Barrio Amon offers a glimpse into the history of the city with colonial mansions converted into art galleries, while Barrio Escalante is a foodie's paradise and the best place to grab dinner to begin your Costa Rica value tour.

Day 2 | San José - Monteverde




Tick off San José's iconic sights with a quick sightseeing tour before travelling towards the creative little town of Sarchí. Seen as the cradle of Costa Rican artisanship, this is the place to buy intricate arts, crafts and souvenirs including the hand-painted and bright coloured oxcart, the national symbol of Costa Rica. The journey continues through the Tilaran Mountain range listening for the collective "oohs" and "aahs" as you enter the mysterious and misty Cloud Forest.

Day 3 | Monteverde sightseeing and free time



Step into another world on your Costa Rica value tour in a cloud forest reserve. Learn about the thousands of plant and animal species that thrive in this area, many of which only exist right here, from your Travel Director. Keep your ears open for the sounds of hummingbirds, howler monkeys, sloths, toucans, and if you're really lucky, the Resplendent Quetzal. Leaving the forest on a nature high, you'll have time to relax this afternoon, or choose from a selection of Choice Experiences, like the 'El Trapiche' tour, where you'll get to visit sugarcane, banana, orange and coffee plantations.

El Trapiche Tour - Get ready for a delicious journey at the "El Trapiche" farm tour. Wander through fields of sugarcane, bananas, oranges, and coffee, diving into the fascinating world of coffee production and sugarcane liquor crafting.

Sky Tram and Sky Trek - Hop on a gondola and soar through treetops, eyes peeled for the locals—yeah, the wildlife kind! As you glide through the forest, watch the greenery shift with the elevation and feel like you're in a live-action nature doc. At the top, you've got a choice: glide back the way you came or amp it up with the Sky Trek. Opt in, and you'll zip across the canopy on ten lines, heights from "whoa" to "OMG" (that's 100 to 524 feet for the number folks) and distances up to a "noway" 2,500 feet. Every zip line is a 360° rainforest immersion!

Sky Tram Up and Down - Get set to elevate your adventure! Hop on a gondola and float through the treetops, eyes peeled for hummingbirds, howler monkeys, sloths, toucans, and other forest dwellers. When you reach the end of the Sky Tram ride coast back down in comfort.

Horseback Riding Tour - Hop on for a horseback adventure with unbeatable views of the Nicoya Gulf and its islands. Saddle up and trot through lush coffee and sugarcane plantations, dense tropical forests, and vast open fields. Keep your eyes peeled for an array of wildlife from toucans and green parrots to playful white-faced monkeys.

Monteverde Cloud Forest Night Walk - Step into the mystical Monteverde Cloud Forest after dark and immerse yourself in a nocturnal adventure. With a Local Guide by your side, dive deep into the heart of this unique ecosystem, uncovering the secrets of the plants and animals that thrive here. As night falls, witness the forest come alive with creatures that emerge in the darkness, offering a rare glimpse into the unseen world of nature.

Day 4 | Monteverde - Arenal

The surrounding landscape teems with tropical flora and fauna, offering opportunities to spot colorful birds, playful monkeys, and even tame iguanas roaming the grounds. After a day of adventure, guests can relax and recharge in a soothing outdoor pool nestled in the heart of this lush paradise.

Keep your eyes peeled on the suspension bridges while spotting birdlife.
