

Day 2 | Budapest, Queen of the Danube

Across the river in Buda, walk with your Local Expert in the Castle District area.

Revolution Walk & St Stephen's - Take a trip back in time to learn of the incredible journey Budapest has taken to once again become the Queen of the Danube. With our local expert, we'll begin with a visit to the Basilica of St Stephen, whose treasures include the most important relic in Hungary; the miraculous Holy Right Hand of the country's first King, St Stephen. Stroll past some of the city's iconic monuments on our way to the jaw-dropping Parliament building, then enjoy a drink before continuing with a visit to the 1956 Underground Museum to hear how the local populace bravely faced the might of the Soviet Union during the famous uprising of that year. We finish our historic walk at the moving "Shoes on the Danube Bank" memorial. Adult: 51.00 EUR

Danube Cruise With Dinner -

Enjoy a sumptuous buffet of the delicious food for which Hungary is famous. Szegedin Goulash (goulash stew), Töltött Káposzta (stuffed cabbage), chicken paprikash, Dobos-Torta and much more. All as you sail along watching the illuminated landmarks of this stunning city.

Day 3 | Free Time in Budapest

Wander past its stunning synagogues, including the legendary Old-New Synagogue, the oldest active synagogue in Europe. Ascend to the historic Strahov Monastery and soak in spectacular panoramic views of Prague's enchanting skyline and the shimmering Vltava River. Marvel at the Strahov Library, a gem of European heritage. Admire its beautifully preserved Baroque Theological Hall and Philosophical Hall, where magnificent frescoed ceilings tell stories of knowledge and faith. Cap off your journey with an authentic Czech experience. Sip on a refreshing beer alongside locals at a cosy pub nestled within the monastery grounds—a perfect way to savour Prague's charm and tradition. Adult: 59.00 EUR

Day 9 | Prague at Leisure



Wind along cobbled lanes and discover a treasure trove of hidden gems as you explore Prague at your own pace. Perhaps cross the border to Germany and explore Dresden? This evening, tantalise your taste buds with a rousing dinner of local specialities at a restaurant.
