Day 1 | Arrive Amsterdam



Start your unforgettable European adventure in Amsterdam. If you can tear your eyes from its scenic canals, you'll be staring at the city's teetering gabled homes that proclaim their birthyear with pride on their colourful facades. Day 2 | Amsterdam – Cologne – Rhine Cruise – Rhine Valley

Day 3 | Rhine Valley – Black Forest – Rhine Falls – Lucerne Region

Day 4 | Lucerne orientation and free time

You could choose to ascend to the alpine heavens, joining an optional scenic cruise across Lake Lucerne, then travel by railway and cable car into the mountains for exhilarating views.

Mount Pilatus And Lake Cruise - Embrace the great outdoors as you travel to Mount Pilatus, ascending its towering summit aboard a thrilling cogwheel train. It doesn't get much better than this! Note: from mid-November to mid-May the ascent will be by a series of cable cars.

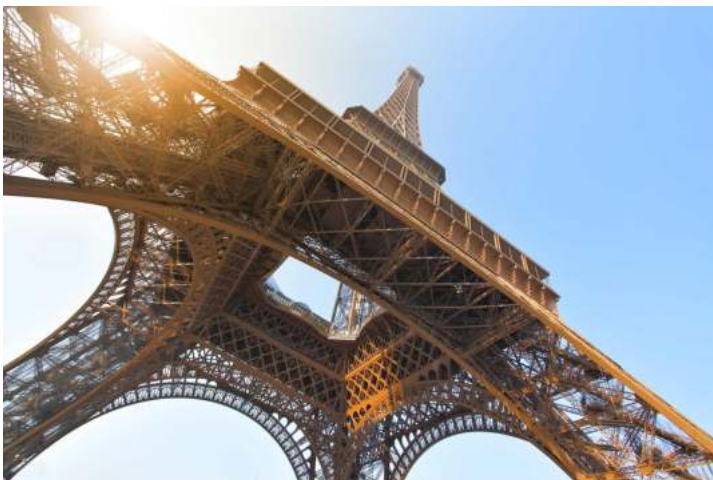
